## Field and goals

The playing field is 40x20m. The goals are 3x2m in size

## Ball

It is played with a size 4 futsal ball.

## Duration of matches

2x 15 minutes , time stops every time the ball goes out .

## Time out

Each team has the right to one time-out during the half-time for one minute. During this break, time it stops.

## Violations

All fouls are accumulated, after 5 fouls and every next one a penalty kick is taken from 10m, if the foul for a penalty kick is made inside the goalkeeper area of 6m, a penalty kick is taken from 6m. If the foul was committed in a zone closer to the goal than 10m, the penalty kick can be taken from the position where the foul was committed or from 10m. All fouls are deleted at halftime.

## Yellow and red card

If a player receives two yellow cards or a red card, his team will play with a player less in the field in the next two minutes, and that player will have to leave the game, without the right to return, after two minutes the expelled player can be replaced by another player from the bench. If a player receives a second yellow card or a red card on the bench, the player must leave the field and the team continues the game with four players and the goalkeeper. The penalty for two yellow cards is one game break, and for a direct red the player will be suspended for two games.

## Goalkeeper game

The goalkeeper cannot receive the ball, in his own half, if it has not been touched by a player of the opposing team. From the outside, the ball can be played directly to the goalkeeper. The goalkeeper can keep the ball in his half for a maximum of 4 seconds. If the goalkeeper touches the ball to which he was not entitled, the referee will award an indirect kick, and award the ball to the opposing team, it will not be written as an accumulated foul.

For all remaining rules that are not provided for in these propositions, the FIFA futsal rules apply.
